You are being suspended for academic standing as a result of your semester grade point average for the semester:

Students placed on Academic Probation for the previous semester (or last semester of attendance) are required to maintain a Semester Grade Point Average of at least 2.0 in order to remain in school.

Your _____ Semester GPA was _____. Therefore, the minimum requirement of a semester GPA of 2.0 was not met.

A student who is suspended at the end of a fall semester must remain out of school for the spring semester. **A student who is suspended at the end of the spring semester may attend the summer session. If the student raises his/her NWLTC cumulative average to 2.0 during the summer session, the student may attend the fall semester.** If the cumulative average remains below 2.0 or if the student does not attend the summer session, the student is suspended for the fall semester.

Unsatisfactory academic progress may affect a student's eligibility to receive any financial assistance.
